Meditating on time and place, home and abroad, in quest of unifying metaphors in an illusory world, *Popular Anatomy* is science fiction in the deepest sense. Plot inflates here like Creation itself, contracting finally to reconcile fiction and history in a novel of thematic dexterity and virtuoso storytelling.
