UNDERSTANDING DEER ANATOMY

MUSCLES PLAY A VITAL ROLE IN MOVEMENT AND POSTURE. KEY MUSCLE GROUPS INCLUDE THOSE IN THE LEGS, BACK, AND NECK, WHICH ARE ESSENTIAL FOR DRAWING THE DYNAMIC POSES OF DEER IN ACTION.

SIGNIFICANCE OF DEER ANATOMY DRAWING
