Though it may have once been a source of consternation or dread, solar eclipses now lead thousands of amateur astronomers and eclipse-chasers to travel the globe in order to experience the dramatic view under totality. These phenomena are among the most spectacular available to observers and are given their full due in Westfall and Sheehan's comprehensive study.
