THE BODY OF YOUR COVER LETTER SHOULD CONSIST OF ONE TO THREE PARAGRAPHS THAT HIGHLIGHT YOUR RELEVANT SKILLS, EXPERIENCES, AND ACHIEVEMENTS. USE SPECIFIC EXAMPLES TO ILLUSTRATE HOW YOUR BACKGROUND ALIGNS WITH THE REQUIREMENTS OF THE JOB. FOCUS ON KEY COMPETENCIES SUCH AS:

- BUSINESS REQUIREMENTS ANALYSIS
- DATA MODELING AND VISUALIZATION
- STAKEHOLDER MANAGEMENT
- PROJECT MANAGEMENT
- PROBLEM-SOLVING ABILITIES

4. CLOSING PARAGRAPH

In your closing paragraph, express your enthusiasm for the opportunity and your desire to discuss your candidacy further. Include a call to action, encouraging the hiring manager to reach out to you for an interview. Thank them for considering your application.

5. SIGNATURE

END WITH A PROFESSIONAL CLOSING STATEMENT, FOLLOWED BY YOUR NAME. IF SUBMITTING A HARD COPY, INCLUDE YOUR HANDWRITTEN SIGNATURE ABOVE YOUR TYPED NAME.

TIPS FOR CUSTOMIZING YOUR COVER LETTER
