SOME CREDIT UNIONS OFFER ADVISORY SERVICES TO HELP BUSINESSES MANAGE THEIR FINANCES, PLAN FOR GROWTH, AND DEVELOP STRATEGIES TO IMPROVE PROFITABILITY.

DIFFERENCES BETWEEN BUSINESS CREDIT UNIONS AND TRADITIONAL BANKS

While both business credit unions and traditional banks serve the financial needs of businesses, there are notable differences between the two. Understanding these differences can help business owners choose the right financial partner.

- Ownership Structure: Credit unions are member-owned, while banks are owned by shareholders. This difference influences how profits are distributed and the overall mission of the institution.

- **EMPLOYEE MEMBERSHIP:** BUSINESSES MAY QUALIFY IF THEIR EMPLOYEES ARE ELIGIBLE FOR MEMBERSHIP BASED ON THE CREDIT UNION'S GUIDELINES.
