CONSIDERATION

CONSIDERATION REFERS TO WHAT EACH PARTY STANDS TO GAIN FROM THE CONTRACT. THIS COULD BE MONETARY PAYMENT, SERVICES RENDERED, OR OTHER FORMS OF VALUE. IT IS ESSENTIAL TO SPECIFY THE CONSIDERATION IN THE CONTRACT TO AVOID CONFUSION LATER ON.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

THE TERMS AND CONDITIONS SECTION OUTLINES THE SPECIFIC OBLIGATIONS OF EACH PARTY. THIS INCLUDES DETAILS SUCH AS DEADLINES, QUALITY STANDARDS, AND ANY OTHER EXPECTATIONS THAT NEED TO BE MET. CLEARLY DEFINED TERMS HELP PREVENT DISPUTES AND ENSURE THAT ALL PARTIES ARE ON THE SAME PAGE.

TERMINATION CLAUSE

A TERMINATION CLAUSE SPECIFIES THE CONDITIONS UNDER WHICH THE CONTRACT CAN BE TERMINATED. THIS IS CRUCIAL FOR PROTECTING BOTH PARTIES IN CASE THE AGREEMENT IS NO LONGER VIABLE. CLEAR GUIDELINES ON HOW TO TERMINATE THE CONTRACT AND ANY CONSEQUENCES OF TERMINATION SHOULD BE INCLUDED.

STEP 5: REVIEW AND REVISE
