CHOOSING THE RIGHT SYMPATHY CARD

- For a Community Tragedy: "Our thoughts are with you and the community during this tragic time. Please let us know how we can assist you."

BEST PRACTICES FOR SENDING SYMPATHY CARDS

- FOLLOW UP: CONSIDER FOLLOWING UP WITH A PHONE CALL OR EMAIL TO OFFER FURTHER SUPPORT AFTER SENDING THE CARD.
