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## ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA FOR FLORIDA REAL ESTATE LICENSE

BEFORE PURSUING A REAL ESTATE LICENSE IN FLORIDA, CANDIDATES MUST MEET SPECIFIC ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS SET BY THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF BUSINESS AND PROFESSIONAL REGULATION (DBPR). THESE CRITERIA ENSURE THAT APPLICANTS ARE QUALIFIED AND PREPARED FOR THE RESPONSIBILITIES OF A REAL ESTATE AGENT.

### AGE AND RESIDENCY REQUIREMENTS

APPLICANTS MUST BE AT LEAST 18 YEARS OLD TO QUALIFY FOR A FLORIDA REAL ESTATE LICENSE. WHILE FLORIDA RESIDENCY IS NOT MANDATORY, INDIVIDUALS MUST HAVE A VALID SOCIAL SECURITY NUMBER OR A COMPARABLE IDENTIFICATION NUMBER TO COMPLY WITH FEDERAL LAW.

### LEGAL STATUS AND BACKGROUND CHECKS

APPLICANTS MUST BE LAWFUL U.S. RESIDENTS OR HOLD LEGAL PERMISSION TO WORK IN THE UNITED STATES. FURTHERMORE, A COMPREHENSIVE BACKGROUND CHECK, INCLUDING FINGERPRINTING, IS REQUIRED TO DISCLOSE ANY CRIMINAL HISTORY. CERTAIN CONVICTIONS MAY DISQUALIFY AN APPLICANT FROM OBTAINING A LICENSE OR REQUIRE ADDITIONAL REVIEW.

## PRE-LICENSING EDUCATION REQUIREMENTS

FLORIDA MANDATES COMPLETION OF STATE-APPROVED PRE-LICENSING EDUCATION COURSES TO PREPARE CANDIDATES FOR THE REAL ESTATE LICENSING EXAM AND PROFESSIONAL PRACTICE. THESE COURSES COVER ESSENTIAL REAL ESTATE PRINCIPLES, LAWS, AND PRACTICES.

## COURSE STRUCTURE AND CONTENT

THE PRE-LICENSING PROGRAM INCLUDES A 63-HOUR COURSE THAT COVERS TOPICS SUCH AS REAL ESTATE PRINCIPLES AND PRACTICES, FLORIDA REAL ESTATE LAW, CONTRACTS, FINANCE, AND ETHICS. THIS EDUCATION PROVIDES A SOLID FOUNDATION FOR UNDERSTANDING THE COMPLEXITIES OF REAL ESTATE TRANSACTIONS WITHIN THE STATE.

## APPROVED EDUCATION PROVIDERS

COURSES MUST BE COMPLETED THROUGH FLORIDA REAL ESTATE COMMISSION (FREC)-APPROVED SCHOOLS OR ONLINE PLATFORMS. SELECTING AN APPROVED PROVIDER ENSURES THE COURSEWORK MEETS STATE STANDARDS AND IS ACCEPTED FOR LICENSING PURPOSES.

## APPLICATION PROCESS AND FEES

THE APPLICATION PROCESS FOR A FLORIDA REAL ESTATE LICENSE INVOLVES SUBMITTING DETAILED PERSONAL INFORMATION, EDUCATIONAL CERTIFICATES, AND PAYING THE REQUIRED FEES. PROPER COMPLETION OF THE APPLICATION IS CRITICAL FOR TIMELY PROCESSING.

## SUBMITTING THE APPLICATION

APPLICANTS MUST SUBMIT THEIR LICENSE APPLICATION TO THE DBPR EITHER ONLINE OR BY MAIL. THE APPLICATION INCLUDES PERSONAL DATA, PROOF OF COMPLETED PRE-LICENSING EDUCATION, AND ACKNOWLEDGMENT OF THE BACKGROUND SCREENING REQUIREMENT.

## FEE STRUCTURE

APPLICATION FEES INCLUDE THE INITIAL LICENSING FEE, FINGERPRINT PROCESSING FEE, AND EXAMINATION FEE. THESE COSTS ARE NON-REFUNDABLE AND NECESSARY FOR PROCESSING THE APPLICATION AND SCHEDULING THE EXAMINATION.

## PASSING THE FLORIDA REAL ESTATE EXAM

AFTER MEETING EDUCATIONAL AND APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS, CANDIDATES MUST PASS THE FLORIDA REAL ESTATE EXAM TO DEMONSTRATE THEIR KNOWLEDGE AND COMPETENCY IN REAL ESTATE PRACTICES AND LAWS.

## EXAM FORMAT AND CONTENT

THE EXAM CONSISTS OF MULTIPLE-CHOICE QUESTIONS COVERING VARIOUS TOPICS SUCH AS REAL ESTATE LAW, FINANCING, CONTRACTS, PROPERTY OWNERSHIP, AND ETHICAL STANDARDS. THE TEST IS DESIGNED TO ASSESS BOTH THEORETICAL KNOWLEDGE AND PRACTICAL APPLICATION.

## PASSING SCORE AND RETAKE POLICY

APPLICANTS MUST ACHIEVE A MINIMUM PASSING SCORE, TYPICALLY 75%, TO QUALIFY FOR LICENSURE. IF UNSUCCESSFUL ON THE FIRST ATTEMPT, CANDIDATES MAY RETAKE THE EXAM AFTER A WAITING PERIOD AS SPECIFIED BY THE DBPR. MULTIPLE RETAKES ARE ALLOWED, PROVIDED THE APPLICANT REMAINS COMPLIANT WITH ALL REQUIREMENTS.

# POST-LICENSING AND CONTINUING EDUCATION

ONCE LICENSED, NEW REAL ESTATE AGENTS IN FLORIDA MUST COMPLETE POST-LICENSING EDUCATION TO MAINTAIN THEIR LICENSE. CONTINUING EDUCATION IS ALSO REQUIRED TO KEEP SKILLS CURRENT AND COMPLY WITH REGULATORY STANDARDS.

## POST-LICENSING EDUCATION

WITHIN THE FIRST RENEWAL PERIOD, LICENSEES MUST COMPLETE A 45-HOUR POST-LICENSING COURSE. THIS COURSE EXPANDS ON INITIAL EDUCATION AND PREPARES AGENTS FOR PRACTICAL REAL ESTATE ACTIVITIES AND COMPLIANCE WITH FLORIDA LAW.

## CONTINUING EDUCATION REQUIREMENTS

AFTER THE INITIAL POST-LICENSING PERIOD, REAL ESTATE PROFESSIONALS MUST COMPLETE 14 HOURS OF CONTINUING EDUCATION EVERY TWO YEARS. THIS EDUCATION INCLUDES UPDATES ON LEGAL CHANGES, ETHICS, AND BEST PRACTICES TO ENSURE ONGOING COMPETENCE AND PROFESSIONALISM.

## ADDITIONAL LICENSING CONSIDERATIONS

THERE ARE SEVERAL OTHER FACTORS AND OPTIONS WITHIN THE FLORIDA REAL ESTATE LICENSING FRAMEWORK THAT APPLICANTS AND LICENSEES SHOULD BE AWARE OF.

## BROKER LICENSE REQUIREMENTS

EXPERIENCED SALES ASSOCIATES MAY PURSUE A BROKER LICENSE, WHICH DEMANDS ADDITIONAL EDUCATION, EXPERIENCE, AND EXAMINATION. BROKERS HOLD GREATER RESPONSIBILITIES, INCLUDING SUPERVISING SALES ASSOCIATES AND MANAGING REAL ESTATE OFFICES.

## RECIPROCITY AND LICENSE TRANSFERS

FLORIDA HAS LIMITED RECIPROCITY AGREEMENTS WITH CERTAIN STATES, ALLOWING LICENSED AGENTS FROM THOSE STATES TO APPLY FOR A FLORIDA LICENSE WITH MODIFIED REQUIREMENTS. UNDERSTANDING THESE AGREEMENTS CAN FACILITATE LICENSING FOR OUT-OF-STATE AGENTS.

## LICENSE RENEWAL AND INACTIVE STATUS

REAL ESTATE LICENSES MUST BE RENEWED BIENNIALY. LICENSEES UNABLE TO MEET CONTINUING EDUCATION OR RENEWAL DEADLINES MAY PLACE THEIR LICENSE ON INACTIVE STATUS, WHICH RESTRICTS THEIR ABILITY TO PRACTICE BUT PRESERVES THEIR CREDENTIALS FOR FUTURE REACTIVATION.

6. FULFILL ONGOING CONTINUING EDUCATION REQUIREMENTS FOR LICENSE RENEWAL.

## FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

### WHAT ARE THE BASIC ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS FOR OBTAINING A FLORIDA REAL ESTATE LICENSE?

TO BE ELIGIBLE FOR A FLORIDA REAL ESTATE LICENSE, YOU MUST BE AT LEAST 18 YEARS OLD, HAVE A HIGH SCHOOL DIPLOMA OR EQUIVALENT, AND POSSESS A SOCIAL SECURITY NUMBER.

### HOW MANY PRE-LICENSING EDUCATION HOURS ARE REQUIRED IN FLORIDA?

FLORIDA REQUIRES 63 HOURS OF APPROVED PRE-LICENSING EDUCATION BEFORE YOU CAN APPLY FOR THE REAL ESTATE LICENSE EXAM.

### WHAT IS THE PROCESS TO APPLY FOR THE FLORIDA REAL ESTATE LICENSE EXAM?

AFTER COMPLETING THE 63-HOUR PRE-LICENSING COURSE, YOU MUST SUBMIT AN APPLICATION TO THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF BUSINESS AND PROFESSIONAL REGULATION (DBPR), PAY THE EXAM FEE, AND SCHEDULE YOUR EXAM.

### ARE THERE ANY BACKGROUND CHECKS REQUIRED FOR FLORIDA REAL ESTATE LICENSE APPLICANTS?

YES, APPLICANTS MUST UNDERGO A FINGERPRINT-BASED BACKGROUND CHECK THROUGH THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF LAW ENFORCEMENT AND THE FBI AS PART OF THE LICENSING PROCESS.
