CODERS MUST UNDERSTAND MEDICAL TERMINOLOGY, ANATOMY, AND HEALTHCARE REGULATIONS TO PERFORM THEIR TASKS EFFECTIVELY.

### IMPORTANCE OF MEDICAL CODING IN HEALTHCARE

### ESSENTIAL MEDICAL CODING SYSTEMS

# ICD-10-CM (International Classification of Diseases, 10th Revision, Clinical Modification)

# HCPCS (HEALTHCARE COMMON PROCEDURE CODING SYSTEM)

HCPCS codes are used primarily to identify products, supplies, and services not included in CPT codes, such as ambulance services and durable medical equipment. The system includes two levels: Level I is identical to CPT codes, and Level II covers non-physician services and products.

# STEP-BY-STEP PROCESS OF MEDICAL CODING

Knowing how to do medical coding involves following a structured workflow to ensure accuracy and compliance. The process includes reviewing documentation, identifying key information, selecting appropriate codes, and verifying code accuracy.

### REVIEWING CLINICAL DOCUMENTATION

## SELECTING THE APPROPRIATE CODES

Using the knowledge of ICD-10-CM, CPT, and HCPCS coding manuals or software tools, coders assign the

CORRECT CODES THAT CORRESPOND TO THE DOCUMENTED INFORMATION. THIS STEP REQUIRES UNDERSTANDING CODING GUIDELINES AND CONVENTIONS TO AVOID ERRORS.

### VALIDATING AND SUBMITTING CODES

AFTER CODE SELECTION, CODERS VERIFY THE ACCURACY AND COMPLETENESS OF THE CODES. THEY ENSURE COMPLIANCE WITH PAYER-SPECIFIC REQUIREMENTS AND CHECK FOR ANY CONFLICTING CODES. ONCE VALIDATED, THE CODES ARE SUBMITTED FOR BILLING AND REIMBURSEMENT PROCESSING.

### EXAMPLE OF MEDICAL CODING WORKFLOW

- 1. OBTAIN THE PATIENT'S MEDICAL RECORD FROM THE HEALTHCARE PROVIDER.
- 2. REVIEW ALL CLINICAL DOCUMENTATION FOR RELEVANT INFORMATION.
- 3. IDENTIFY THE PRIMARY AND SECONDARY DIAGNOSES AND PROCEDURES.
- 4. Consult coding manuals or software for code selection.
- 5. APPLY CODING GUIDELINES AND CROSS-CHECK CODES.
- 6. Enter codes into the billing system for claim submission.

### TOOLS AND RESOURCES FOR MEDICAL CODERS
