INDUCTIVE STUDY VALUES THE ORIGINAL AUDIENCE'S PERSPECTIVE AND THE AUTHOR'S INTENT, MAKING IT A RELIABLE METHOD FOR ACCURATE BIBLICAL INTERPRETATION.

HISTORICAL BACKGROUND OF INDUCTIVE STUDY

INTERPRETATION: UNDERSTANDING WHAT THE TEXT MEANS

AFTER OBSERVATION, INTERPRETATION SEEKS TO CLARIFY THE MEANING BEHIND THE WORDS. THIS STEP INVOLVES:

- CONSIDERING THE HISTORICAL AND CULTURAL CONTEXT OF THE PASSAGE
- CONSULTING RELATED SCRIPTURES FOR CROSS-REFERENCES
- ANALYZING THE AUTHOR'S INTENT AND THEOLOGICAL THEMES
- USING BIBLE DICTIONARIES OR COMMENTARIES FOR DIFFICULT TERMS OR CONCEPTS
