DIFFICULTIES IN VISUAL PERCEPTION CAN LEAD TO CHALLENGES IN ACADEMIC PERFORMANCE, COORDINATION, AND OVERALL LEARNING. THEREFORE, TARGETED EXERCISES EMBEDDED IN WORKSHEETS ARE VITAL TOOLS FOR ASSESSING AND ENHANCING THESE SKILLS.

- VISUAL CLOSURE: RECOGNIZING A COMPLETE FIGURE EVEN WHEN PARTS ARE MISSING OR OBSCURED.

Types of Visual Perception Exercises in Worksheets
