california spanish textbooks: The California Text-book José de Urcullu, 1852 First edition of a title commonly referred to as "The First Text-Book Printed in California;" although Augustin Vicente Zamorano issued three small educational pamphlets in the 1830s. Cowan more accurately writes "This is believed to be the first educational work published in California after American rule." It was sold by one of the earliest California booksellers, Marvin & Hitchcock, and published by them in San Francisco just three years after the conquest of California from Mexico. It is unknown who adapted Urcullu's Spanish Grammar for California, but one candidate that has been suggested is A. Armstrong--John Howell for Books catalog, California Books and Ephemera, July 1, 2014.
