His students have nominated him for the College of DuPage Outstanding Faculty Award in 2001, 2002, 2003, 2004, 2006, 2007, and 2009. Ken is the

former National President of Psi Beta, the National Honor Society in Psychology for Community Colleges, as well as the co-advisor of the College of DuPage chapter. He has given over 25 presentations on teaching and learning at regional and national conferences since 2000.
