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how many books in acotar: *Vigilante Feminists and Agents of Destiny* Laura Mattoon D'Amore, 2021-04-07 This interdisciplinary study examines the relationship between violence, empowerment, and the teenage super/heroine in comics and young adult fantasy novels. The author analyzes stories

of teenage super/heroines who have experienced trauma, abduction, assault, and sexual violence that has led to a loss of agency, and then tracks the way that their use of violence empowers them to reclaim agency over their lives and bodies. The author identifies these characters as vigilante feminist teenage super/heroines because they become vigilantes in order to protect other girls and young women from violence and create safer communities. The teenage super/heroines examined in this book are characters who have the ability—through super power, or supernatural and magical ability—to fight back against those who seek to cause them harm. They are a product of and a response to both the pervasive culture of violence against girls and women and a system that fails to protect girls and women from harm. While this book is part of a robust intellectual conversation about the role of girls and women in popular literature and culture and about feminist analyses of comics and YA literature, it is unique in its reading of violence as empowerment and in its careful tracing—and naming—of the teenage vigilante super/heroine, a characterization that is hugely popular and deserves this close reading.

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how many books in acotar: *Understanding (Post)feminist Girlhood Through Young Adult Fantasy Literature* Elizabeth Little, 2024-11-04 *Understanding (Post)feminist Girlhood Through Young Adult Fantasy Literature* takes advantage of growing critical interest in popular young adult texts and their influence on young people. The monograph offers an innovative approach by pairing traditional literary analysis with the responses of readers to show the complex ways that young people respond to the depiction of female protagonists. In the first section, the book utilises a feminist framework to examine young adult fantasy novels published from 2012 to 2018, with a particular focus on *A Court of Thorns and Roses* (Maas, 2015) and *Red Queen* (Aveyard, 2015). The analysis shows how strong female protagonists in young adult fantasy are postfeminist heroines who reinscribe patriarchal power structures, embrace limited understandings of gender roles, and persist in relationships that oppress them. In the second section, the monograph introduces empirical data from a series of focus groups discussing those same novels. The discussion shows that readers respond to these popular young adult fantasy texts with complexity and nuance that highlights their postfeminist subjectivities as they simultaneously reject and reinscribe elements of postfeminism in their understanding of the girl protagonists.

how many books in acotar: *Las Obras en Verso Del Príncipe de Esquilache* Javier Jiménez Belmonte, 2007 Este volumen ofrece el primer estudio monográfico sobre uno de los poetas más citados y peor conocidos del barroco español: Francisco de Borja, príncipe de Esquilache. Sus Obras en verso, publicadas por primera vez en 1648, constituyen uno de los proyectos laureados más elaborados y conscientes de la primera mitad del XVII. No sólo se trata de uno de los pocos cancioneros barrocos españoles curados y editados por su propio autor, sino también del primer volumen de poesía dado a la imprenta por un miembro de la alta aristocracia castellana.
